ТӨБЦ 030 Khadanlamin (Rinchen 374: Khaadanlamin sum (Moiltin Khoural))

Current situation (2004)

Today, the only remains are the stone foundations of three temples: one small temple in the west; one in the east; and the main temple set back from these two and to the north. All the foundations are rectangular. The entrance of the western temple faces south. There are no plans to restore the temples. In 2003, people from Ulaanbaatar were digging at this place.

Oral Histories

This was a small Khoural with around a dozen monks and it belonged to the Yellow Sect (Gelugpa). The wood used to make the temples was reddish yellow and the roof was maroon. The monastery possessed a herd. It was destroyed in the 1930's. The monks were arrested.
