Current situation

The Bor Khoendii Jas watermill, the Jasin Khudag, is still used today to produce drinking water. It is close to the Tuul river to the north west of the temple at an elevation of 978 metres. GPS of Bor Khoendii Jasin Khudag The source led the survey team to a small pile of stones nearby, which is all that is left at the site of the monastery.
